Table 1 (closest to copy center):

- Vital Records of NY from the 1800's
- LDS Research Outlines
- Guides to City Directories
- State Censuses (example: 1925 IA asked father and mother name)
- Cemetery and Mortuary guides

Table 2

- Binder for passports (1795-1925), LDS holds entire collection of applications
- Immigration binder – NEVER use the catalog for immigration

Table 3 (Military)

- State and Local Sources for Civil War, and Index to Civil War Pension Applications and Service Records
- Draft Registration Cards
- Virgil White's Revolutionary War Pension abstracts (floors 1-3 reference)

- Canadian Research binder

- Index to all post 1837 Vital Records is on microfiche by quarters of years (with IGI information)
- "Smith" inventories of manuscripts (blue set on wall)

- Phillimore's Atlas and Index of Parish Registers (with IGI and other information)
